<input type="checkbox"/> Capital Gains — If you have sold stocks, bonds, mutual funds (not held in an RRSP) land, cottages (not principal residence), farms or businesses, you must declare the gain or loss in the year of the sale.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Carrying Charges — Costs associated with earning investment income. Note examples: <i>safety deposit box, brokers' fees, borrowing costs, bank service fees, investment counseling fees, accounting fees, management fees, interest on money borrowed to buy Investments (not RRSP), Canada Savings Bond payroll deduction charges.</i>
